Are you subject to threats and/or violence?

- Do you live in a relationship where your freedom is limited by your partner or another person close to you?
- Does your partner or another person close to you use demeaning words or offend you in other ways?
- Has your partner or another person close to you intimidated, threatened or used violence against you?

If you have children – please consider that they are exposed as well. Neither you, nor your children are well living in violence.

Among other things, the Individual and Family Care can offer you:

- Advice and support to change your situation
- Sheltered housing and applying for/acquiring new permanent housing
- Economical or material support
- Family legal issues concerning custody and visitation
- Contact with volunteer organisations and other authorities
